**Planning approved for the site known as Culgrenagh on Church Road / Churchview Road (Ref: 304823)**

As you are all aware the closing date for observations to this planning application was 06/08/19. On 17/10/19 An Bord Pleanála communicated their decision that they **have approved** the proposed development. This decision was reached by reviewing the file which included all the planning details, all observations received and a response from DLRCoCo.

What we have done since hearing about the application:

- Delivered a specific Newsletter to all 680 houses in Watson's.
- Followed this newsletter up with door to door calling and a second more detailed newsletter.
- In conjunction with the Watson Road Action Group written and submitted an observation.
- Written to all the Cllr's and TD's in our area asking they support the concerns detailed in our observation.
- Attended DLRCoCo council chambers to witness an extraordinary meeting called for Cllr's to discuss the proposed development.



**Hands For Life First Aid/CPR Training**

Hands for Life CPR / First Aid training ran in conjunction with **The Irish Heart Foundation** successfully took place in the Pastoral Centre on 25/09/19. There were three fully booked sessions with 90 residents present on the night facilitated by Des Kelly on behalf of The Irish Heart Foundation. We would like to sincerely thank The Irish Heart Foundation, ESB Networks, Abbott (who funded the training) and the Parish and Pastoral Centre for hosting the event.

**DLRCoCo Tidy District, 2019**

Unfortunately this year we did not win in our category in DLRCoCo's Tidy District's competition, but we were runners up winning a €300 prize!

**Our results were:**

- Overall presentation of the estate: 8/10
- Road and street presentation: 12/15
- Landscaping: 8/10
- Natural amenities and habitats: 8/10
- Absence of litter: 17/20
- Graffiti Management: 15/15
- Voluntary Community Participation: 13/15
- Communication with residents: 5/5.

**Overall result: 86/100.**

**Comments:** The judges noted our positive move from annual to perennial planting, the cleanliness of the estate and our ongoing efforts to rapidly remove graffiti. While we clearly have things to work on, the committee are delighted with our overall score as we have had a number of changes this year.

**Time: 8 'till late**

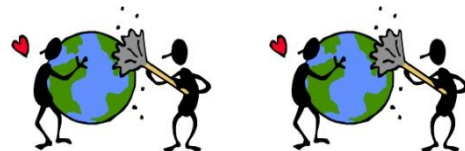
**Where: Function room upstairs in The Graduate**
