As an Irish resident you are entitled to get healthcare through the public system in countries of the European Union (EU), European Economic Area (EEA) or Switzerland if you become ill or injured while on a temporary stay there. The EHIC card allows the holder to access such services.

There is no charge for the EHIC card. The HSE does not charge a processing fee, it is a free public service.

Watsons Road Safety Week 2nd – 9th of April

As part of our efforts to improve road safety within the estate, we are trialing a road safety week from the 2^{nd} to the 9^{th} of April. During this week motorists throughout the estate will be encouraged to voluntarily reduce their speed to 30 km/h. Signage will be erected throughout the estate to remind motorists. We would appreciate your cooperation during the week as we attempt to improve road safety for all users.

DLRCoCo 30Km/h Pilot Project

DLRCoCo are shortly commencing a programme to introduce a reduced speed limit of 30km/h within housing estates. 6 estates within the DLRCoCo are taking part in the pilot project which will measure the effectiveness of speed alert signage as a measure to reduce traffic speed. Watsons has been chosen as one of these 6 estates. During the summer speed alert signs will be introduced into the estate, which will alert drivers to the speed they are travelling at and record average traffic speeds for a period of 6 months. These records will then determine if physical traffic calming measures will be required within the estate to force traffic to slow down.
